- Recent graduates of a recognised book &/or paper conservation training program (2021- 2023).
- Theoretical understanding and practical experience of conservation treatments (paper and/or book or parchment)
- Experience in surveying/ dealing with large collections
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Excellent written, verbal & IT communication skills

Stipend (12-month): €37,000 (subject to normal statutory deductions)

Applicants should ensure that they are eligible when applying to live and work in Ireland.
